ABC Teams Racing Conditions and Rules

1. NZ BAI and ABC venue specific rules apply
2. The race officers/organiser will decide whether to start racing or not
3. A team will consist of up to 5 blokart sailors
4. Only the first 4 finishers of each team count for points in each match
5. If there are 4 per team, then the first 3 will count
6. A team will match race one or two other teams in each match
7. The draw will be posted on race day
8. Each team will be identified by a coloured pulley whip flag. These will be supplied
9. The course will be set so each race will finish within approx. 8 minutes but may be shortened or abandoned at the discretion of the race officer
10. After the first four blokarts in each team have finished the race may be stopped
11. The grass is **not** an obstruction
12. Keep talking, common sense and sportsmanship prevails
13. A sailor may sail another competitor in the same match away from the mark if executed in a safe manner and in accordance of the rules
14. If there is a draw between the top teams then the winner of the final round robin match will take the highest placing. If this doesn't decide the winner then the team with the highest points of the first round robin will be the winner.

Team points for each match if it is a 3 team race:

- win 5
- draw for first 4
- second 3
- draw for second 2
- third 1
- DNC 0

Bonus points:

- win with 1, 2, 3 finish 1 point

Team points for each match if it is a 2 team race:

- win 5
- draw 3
- loss 1
- DNC 0

Bonus points:

- win with 1, 2, 3 finish 1 point

Blokart sailing is a fun activity. The idea for this event is to bring blokart sailors together from different areas for a fun day but within a competitive environment.

Equipment Rules:

BAI rules apply. Apply to race organiser for any exemptions.

Changes to Current Rules

Protests

After the protest form has been filled out by those involved, a protest panel of 3 will be formed, made up of race officers and/or senior sailors. The protest panel will meet with the protestee and protestor, hear comments and make an immediate decision.
