## Notice of Race

# Ardmore Winter Series 2016

#### **Dates:**

15 May – 12.40pm briefing and update followed by race start (back up day 22 May)  
26 June – 12.40pm briefing and update followed by race start (back up day 3 July)  
24 July – 12.40pm briefing and update followed by race start (back up day 31 July)  
28 August – 12.40pm briefing and update followed by race start (back up day 4 Sept)  
25 September – 12.40pm briefing and update followed by race start

*If a day is abandoned then the race day may be held on the back up day*

#### **Format:**

- Three classes:
  1. Performance, two divisions: under 82.5 kg, 82.5 kg and over
  2. Cruiser, for new or more casual sailors
- Number of entries will dictate whether classes will run separately or be combined
- 2 classes or divisions may be raced together but will have separate results
- Electronic timing may be used, karts must have a transponder (can be hired at \$5 per race day)
- There will be both scratch and handicap prizes
- Scrutineering may be held on the grid and randomly during the series
- A minimum of 6 races for a series
- After 8 races a competitor can drop their worst performance, 15 races two drops, 21 races 3 drops

**Fee:** \$40 for the series or \$10 per day (not including transponder hire) for members  
\$25 student members (not including transponder hire)  
Non-members, \$60 for the series or \$15 per day (not including transponder hire)  
Go to ABC shop to enter  
Protest fee: \$10 returned to protester if the protest is upheld.

#### **Course and start**

Will be outlined at the briefing and may be changed during the day. A course may be shortened by race officials during a race

#### **Rules**

NZBAI rules apply plus the ABC venue specific rules on the ABC website. Any changes to the rules made at the briefing takes precedent over published rules
