Notice of Race 2019 Post Xmas Race Series Ardmore

Dates:

13 January, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
20 January, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
10 February, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
17 February, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
24 February, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
10 March, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
17 March, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
24 March, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start
7 April, Sunday – 2.30 pm briefing and immediate race start

Format:

- Three divisions: lights (under 82.5 kg), heavies (82.5 kg and over), Cruiser class for new or inexperienced sailors
- A division with low series entries may be included in another division. Divisions may be run concurrently
- Electronic timing may be used, karts must have a transponder (can be hired at \$5 per day)
- Points will be allocated for a sailor's overall results for each race day. 1 point for finishing 1st, 2 points for 2nd 3 points for 3rd etc
- There must be 2 races for a division to qualify as a race day and after 6 races one can be dropped for the day
- Points from each race day are accumulated to get an overall winner
- 5 race days count towards your overall points
- A scratch and handicap series will be run

Fee: \$40 for the series or \$10 per night (not including transponder hire)
Youth, \$20 for series or \$5 per night (not including transponder hire)
Non-club members pay an extra \$10 for the series or extra \$5 per night
Protest fee: \$10, refunded if protest is won
