**Fee:** Payable through the ABC Shop only  
\$50 for the series or \$10 per day (not including transponder hire)  
Youth \$30 for series or \$5 per day (not including transponder hire)  
Non-club members pay an extra \$10 for the series or extra \$5 per day  
Transponder hire is \$5 per day

**Format:**

- Three Divisions:
  1. Performance Class - Lightweight Division: under 82.5 kg
  2. Performance Class - Heavyweight Division: over 82.5 kg
  3. Cruiser Class - for new or inexperienced sailors (no weight divisions)
- All three divisions may be run together.
- Races may be abandoned by race officers because of lack of wind.
- Electronic timing will be used, karts must have a transponder.
- Low point scoring will apply.
- A minimum 2 races for a division to qualify as a race day and after 6 races one can be dropped for the day.
- Your best 5 race day results count towards your overall series points.
- Protest fee: \$10 returned to protester if the protest is upheld.

**Course:** Will be outlined at the briefing and may be changed during the day or shortened during the race, by race officers.

**Rules:**

Racing will be in accordance with IBRA Sailing Rules (Edition 8), link below Ardmore rules located on the website and any site-specific rules outlined at briefing.
