Gates open at 12pm with briefing at 12.45 and racing to start at 1pm.

21st May - Ardmore

18th June – Ardmore (or Glinks)

16th July – Ardmore

17th September – Ardmore

The Sunday of the following weekend may be used as a backup day if racing is postponed.

** If Ardmore is unavailable or there is a change of venue, this will be communicated via WhatsApp.

Fee: Payable through the ABC Shop only
\$20 for the series or \$10 per day (not including transponder hire)
Youth \$10 for series or \$5 per day (not including transponder hire)
Non-club members pay an extra \$10 for the series or extra \$5 per day
Transponder hire is \$5 per day

Format:

- Three Divisions:
 1. Performance Class - Lightweight Division: under 82.5 kg
 2. Performance Class - Heavyweight Division: over 82.5 kg
 3. Cruiser Class - for new or inexperienced sailors (no weight divisions)
- All three divisions may be run together.
- Races may be abandoned by race officers because of lack of wind.
- Electronic timing will be used, karts must have a transponder.
- Low point scoring will apply.
- A minimum of 5 races for a series
- After 6 races a competitor can drop their worst performance, 12 races two drops, 18 races 3 drops and 24 races 4 drops.
- Protest fee: \$10 returned to protester if the protest is upheld.

Course: Will be outlined at the briefing and may be changed during the day or shortened during the race, by race officers.

Rules:

Racing will be in accordance with IBRA Sailing Rules (Edition 8), link below Ardmore rules located on the website and any site-specific rules outlined at briefing.
